EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2017-05 AND ESTABLISHING A
NEW POLICY FOR BURIALS OF BODIES FOUND WITHIN THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ENON OHIO**

WHEREAS: The Village of Enon wishes to establish a policy to comply with the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code Section 9.15 pertaining to the burial of the body of a dead person that is found within the corporate limits of the Village of Enon and the body is not claimed for private internment; and

WHEREAS, The Village had previously enacted Ordinance 2017-05 and said ordinance shall be repealed, replaced, and superseded by the Ordinance and shall have no further force and effect.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Enon, Clark County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1: When the body of a dead person is found in the Village, and such person was not an inmate of a correctional, benevolent, or charitable institution of this state, and the body is not claimed by any such person for private internment or cremation at the person's own expense, or delivered for the purpose of medical or surgical study or dissection in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 1713.34, it shall be disposed of in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 9.15

SECTION 2: This Emergency Ordinance is effective immediately upon its enactment and signing by the Mayor and Village Fiscal Officer.
