EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2026-01

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT A CYBERSECURITY PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 9.64, enacted through House Bill 96, the Village is required to adopt a cyber security program that safeguards public data, information technology, and Information Technology (IT) resources to ensure confidentiality, availability, and integrity; and

WHEREAS, the law mandates use of generally accepted cybersecurity best practices, including frameworks, such as the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Cybersecurity Framework and the Center for Internet Security best practices; and

WHEREAS, Council, having reviewed the recommendations of the Village's IT Coordinator, the Village hereby adopts the NIST Cybersecurity Framework as its foundational cyber security controls framework.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED: by the Council of the Village of Enon, Ohio, that:

SECTION I: The Village hereby adopts a cybersecurity program consistent with the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Section 9.64(C) and aligned with generally accepted best practices, such as the NIST Cybersecurity Framework.

SECTION II: The cybersecurity program shall implement the NIST Cybersecurity Framework to identify and mitigate risks, assess potential impacts, detect and respond to threats, restore affected systems, and maintain ongoing protection of Village assets and data. The program shall include annual cybersecurity training for all employees, align with state and federal best practices, and ensure third-party providers meet applicable security standards to achieve practical, measurable, and cost-effective improvements in defending against cyber threats such as ransomware and phishing.

SECTION III: The IT coordinator, in coordination with the Village Administrator and Administrative Assistant, shall oversee the implementation, documentation, and annual review of the cybersecurity program to ensure continued alignment with state requirements and best practices.

SECTION IV: All records and documents related to the Village's cyber security program are exempt from public records disclosure, consistent with Ohio Revised Code Section 9.64(E).

SECTION V: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its public committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION VI: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity to adopt a cybersecurity program to be in compliance with ORC Section 9.64. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force of effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
