RESOLUTION TO PROCEED OF THE TAXING AUTHORITY

(Revised Code, Sec. 5705.19, .191, .192, .194, .21, .26)

The Council of The Village of Enon, met in Regular session on January 27, 2026 at the office of the Council with the following members present:

- Ms. Leist, Mrs. Sweet
Mr. Bear, Mr. Whitacre
Mr. Davoli and Mr. Hanna

Ms. Leist moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the said The Village of Enon, Clark County; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council, Clark County, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of The Village of Enon for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent and part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, or the payment of other related costs (per Ohio Rev. Code § 5705.19(j))

at a rate not exceeding 2.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$88 for each one hundred thousand dollars of valuation for five (5) commencing and appearing on the tax list for the years 2026-2030 with an estimated annual collection amount of \$115,981 per year.


