**Administrative Report:** Jason Rose for Kevin Siferd

Submitted OPWC application for the Waste Water Line replacement from water treatment plant to Mad River, line is aged. Will try to use funds from OPWC and then remainder out of water department funds-good for one year. Kevin, Jason and Chief Holler met with CND Security on security cameras at water treatment plant and Enon Park, 12 to 15 years old, Mayor agrees they need replaced.

Have been in contact with Choice One Engineering to submit a TIP application on behalf of the village for Main Street improvement project-consists of main street intersection and street lighting, extends past government center up to library, estimated cost \$1,839,215.00

Recent meeting with Clark County Engineers, Clark Co, Utilities and Marathon about Marathon pipeline at school: discussing removal of casing on pipeline. Needs to be done for future Storm Water Project.

Everything is ready to pour concrete pads at Settler’s Park.
